 - Frequent healthcare contact

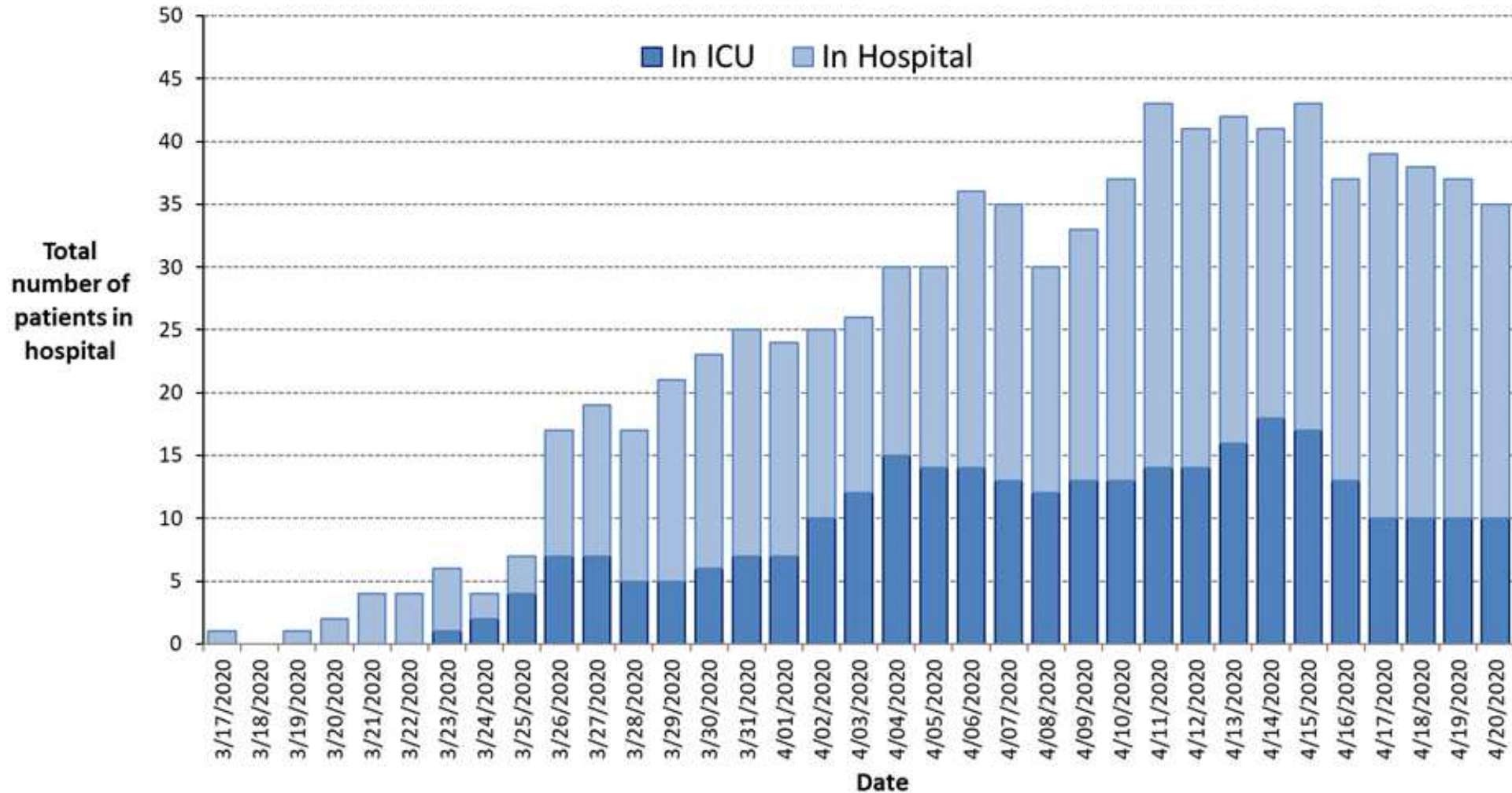

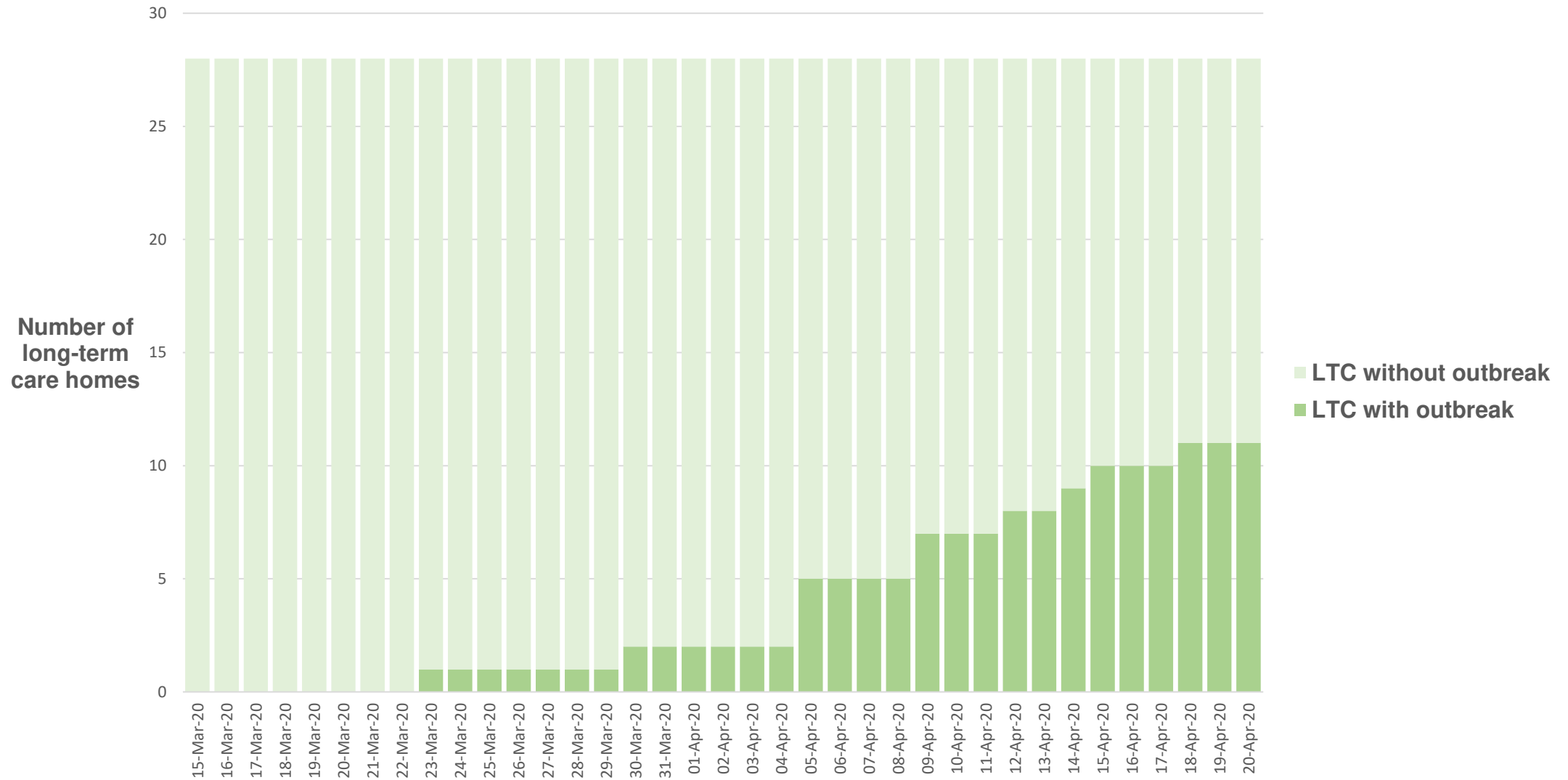

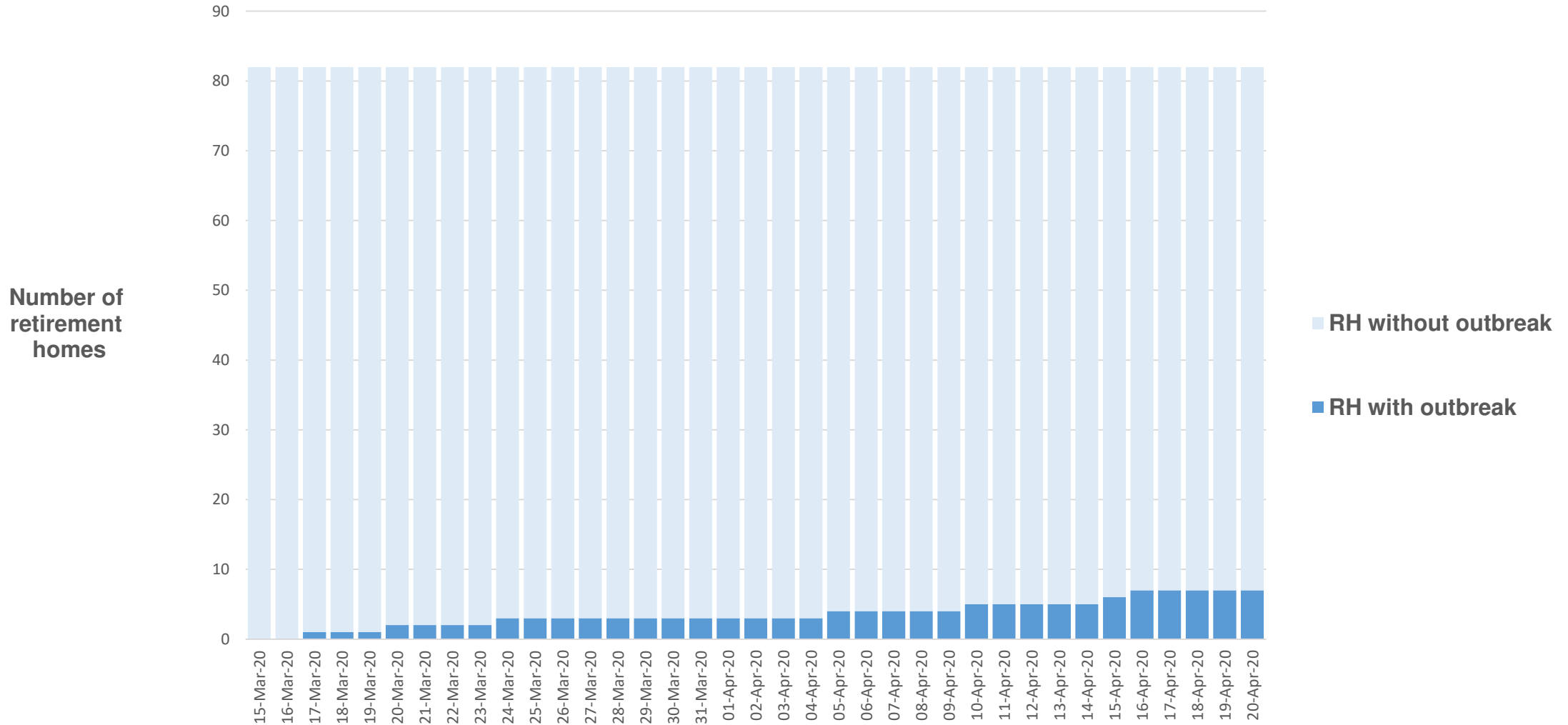
Hospitalizations and ICU trends

- Community Use of Face Coverings and Home-Made Masks

What is Physical (Social) Distancing?



Keep a distance of 2m (6 feet) when going out



Avoid large gatherings



Work from home if possible



Avoid visiting elderly friends or relatives



Conduct meetings or visits virtually



Limit contacts to household members
