- **Senior of the Year:** Awarded in recognition of a senior citizen who has made a significant and long-standing contribution to our community.
- **Business of the Year:** Awarded to a local business that goes above and beyond in order to support the community and make it a better place in which to live.
- **Volunteer Group of the Year:** Awarded to a group of citizens who are actively working together in order to make a difference in the Stittsville community.
- **The John Curry Memorial Youth of the Year:** Awarded to a young person who exemplifies leadership, inspires their peers and has made a significant contribution to the community through volunteer service.
- **Teacher of the Year:** Awarded in recognition of an outstanding teacher who makes a difference in the lives of Stittsville Students. A teacher that goes above and beyond to support students and inspires the next generation of leadership in the community.
